Conditions of the Competition:

The Championship is a 36-hole stroke play event. The USGA Rules of Golf shall govern all play. All decisions made by the Tournament Committee concerning the competition are final. In addition, the following rules are in effect:

- Summer Rules are in effect.
- > Blue Tee markers are in use for the tournament. Yardage on the scorecard is measured from the Blue Tee Monuments.
- In the event of a tie for the Championship, the winner will be decided on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine, determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes and finally the 18th hole. Then if there is no winner, a tie is accepted.
- > DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES we WILL BE using the local rule that allows players to use GPS, Laser or any other artificial form of DISTANCE ONLY measuring devices.
- > Embedded Ball Relief under Rule 25-2 is expanded to "through the green".
- Late to the Tee The note under Rule 6-3 will be used as an optional condition as prescribed.
- > Times for Sunday June 28th will be either e-mailed to you or by phone the afternoon/evening of the 27th.
- You must return your scorecard to the scoring area immediately following your round.
- Dress Code All players and caddies shall wear appropriate golf attire at all times during tournament rounds. Neat and clean slacks, Bermudas, or walking shorts (mid thigh in length) and golf shirts with collars are appropriate. No cutoffs, T-shirts, jeans or colored denim are allowed. Shoes must be worn at all times. Failure to adhere to this dress code will result in disqualification.

HINTS TO SPEED PLAY:

- Play a second ball if you think the first ball is in doubt. This saves going back to play a Second ball.
- Putt out if possible. Attempt to not mark every putt.
- > Play "ready golf" at all times.
